


Project Area Map

Project Overview

Traffic Control

Racine County will maintain through-traffic during the course of this project. Motorists may use highway "D" to access the homes and businesses within the project area. The contractor will work to maintain normal school bus service. Of course, motorists should budget more travel time to allow for minor delays. Expect temporary prohibition of highway "D" on-street parking from State St to Front St. The Contractor plans to allow parking on Fridays and weekends.

Preparatory Work

The Contractor will begin work on the project by placing stakes near some of the construction areas. These stakes lie outside of the construction area and help guide the workers. This preparatory work will occur within the county highway right-of-way and will not affect private property. Workers will restore topsoil and seed disturbed areas.

Road-base preparation

The contractor will begin this phase of the project by milling the surface of the existing asphalt pavement. Racine County recycles milled material for use as road maintenance gravel. This milled surface will provide a strong, smooth support for the first layer of new asphalt pavement. The contractor will maintain the existing road shape and position. Expect small changes near cross-road intersections.

Pavement

When the milling is complete, the contractor will place the first layer of asphalt. Next, the contractor will lay the final course of pavement including the replacement of asphalt driveway approaches and cross-road intersections. With pavement finished, the contractor will place temporary pavement markings to highlight the highway centerline.

Completion

Racine County surveyed the existing driveway pavement so that the contractor can restore asphalt driveway approaches to their original shape and position. As workers complete the final layer of asphalt pavement, they will replace the gravel driveway approaches and shoulders. At this stage, the contractor will apply fresh pavement markings on the new asphalt surface.
